Ocean Tours

Isla Palenque is our 4000 - acres, private tropical island resort, a rare place in which 7 secluded beaches meet the virgin rainforest. Thanks to this fantasy island privileged location, ocean activities are a must to experience. We invite you to dive into the crystalline waters, enjoy the beautiful landscapes from the comfort of your boat as you embark on open water adventures and low impact water activities.



Kayak: Piñalitas

Isla Palenque's northeast coast features two islets that shelter one of the island's most enchanting natural attractions: a shallow sand-bottomed cave, home to a tiny species of insectivorous bat. Take an invigorating journey by kayak along our rocky coast to explore this incredible corner of the island.

Kayak: Beaches & Mangroves of Boca Brava

Paddle out towards neighbouring Boca Brava at high tide to discover our mangrove-lined northeast coast from the open waters. Explore this mysterious and enigmatic ecosystem where the rainforest meets the ocean with a guide and learn all about its importance for marine life.

Kayak: Isla Palenquito


Strike out from the sandy shores of Playa Primera and paddle a half-mile over the sparkling Pacific to reach Isla Palenquito, a charming little isle to our north. Upon landing at Palenquito, you'll find an intriguing little beach that very few have ever visited. Enjoy its coral sands and coconut groves before returning by kayak to the island you call home.

Stand-Up Paddleboard

Take one of our paddleboards from Playa Palenque and head out on the open ocean with our guide who'll take you to any number of locations along our shores, depending on the swells and experience level of the group. If you are new to stand-up paddleboarding, we recommend arriving half an hour in advance to get some practice balancing, paddling and turning.

Rock Fishing

Head out to our shallow bays at low tide for some prime inshore fishing from our rocky coastline. The locals have been known to hook catfish, snapper, roosterfish, snook, jack and even trevally in our waters – try reeling one in with artisanal fishing tackle for added thrills.

*Island Hopping in the Gulf of Chiriquí

Explore the virgin shores of Isla Palenque's island neighbors in the Gulf of Chiriquí National Marine Park. Our most popular island-hopping tour takes you to two nearby deserted islands, Isla Bolaños for swimming and snorkeling, and Isla Gamez for a good dose of beach chill time. Along the way, enjoy beautiful views, catch sight of jumping fish, dolphins and rays, and even spot a humpback whale or two from late August to early October.

*Islas Secas

Hop your way over to the remote Islas Secas past the rocky isles of Islas Monitas and Punta Bejuca. There, you'll enjoy some prime snorkelling, swimming, and hiking either side of a fresh, fire-grilled lunch at Isla Paridas, with plenty of time to simply kick back and relax. The 60-minute journey back to Isla Palenque provides a drive-by view of the beautiful Islas Viudas and Isla San Jose, as well as the opportunity to spot jumping fish and rays, sea birds, dolphins and even whales from late August to early October.

*Inshore Sport Fishing

Learn how the Gulf of Chiriquí earned its title as the big game sport fishing capital of the world. From our dock in Playa Giron, you'll head out to the nearby islands for a chance to catch roosterfish and bonito, snook and mackerel. Bring back you catch of the day and we'll rustle up some fresh fish tacos or a delicious dish of your choice back on the island

*Whale Watching

August through October brings the humpback whales to the warm protected waters of the Gulf of Chiriquí. Whales migrate here from cooler climes in order to give birth and spend a few months teaching their little ones the ways of the wild ocean. As the season progresses, the babies show off their new skills, breaching and putting on magnificent shows. Dolphins often tag along too. Witness these incredible creatures, twice the size of our boat, from as close as 30ft.

*Boquete: Coffee & Cloud Forests

A town of fine Panamanian coffee and scenic views over mist-mantled peaks, Boquete is quite the memorable daytrip. Stroll through the quaint streets of the downtown area sampling the local cuisine and picking up artisan souvenirs before enjoying two excursions of your choice. Choose to go coffee tasting, hiking, on a honey tour, or adventuring across a network of hanging bridges. Alternatively, adrenaline-seekers may prefer to glide over the cloud forest on a canopy zip line tour (+\$35pp).

Island Hikes

These guided hikes take you to several different areas of the island, allowing you to discover the intricacies of Isla Palenque's unique ecosystems. As you progress from the beauty of old-growth jungle to sprawling, palm-fringed beaches, your guide will point out myriad flora and fauna while describing the interconnected ecologies of our wild island. Treks include birdwatching, walks through lagoon ecosystems and lush hillsides, and other activities depending on the season.

Tide Pools & Mangroves

Gain a deeper understanding of the island's remarkable aquatic ecotones: rare white mangroves that protect the island from the ocean while sheltering delicate marine life; bird-filled lagoons tucked just behind our beaches; and treasure-filled tide pools, revealed only in the receding waters of low tide. These are some of the most biodiverse corners of the island, best appreciated with the help of a guide.

Hike to Punta Ballena

Spotted the magnificent spray of the blowhole at Punta Ballena from Playa Palenque? To witness this natural wonder up close, duck into the jungle to climb a gently sloping path that runs through old-growth forest and alongside a lagoon humming with birds and butterflies. You'll emerge atop a bluff to be greeted by a spectacular vista of the Gulf of Chiriquí, with the blowhole erupting from the rocks below, showering you in its cool, refreshing mist.

Cala Este Hike

Follow the singsong of exotic birds along the Paso Mangle trail past the mangroves and down to Cala Este beach. There you'll emerge from the trees on the south east of the island, greeted by glorious views out to sea and a breath of ocean air. From these warm sands, you'll return to the trail – a favorite hangout of the howler monkeys – and continue along the coast to Playa Primera, discovering the intense biodiversity that thrives where the rainforest meets the ocean.

Birdwatching

Rise bright and early to explore our shores before breakfast in search of the birdlife that calls Isla Palenque home. With a pair of binoculars to hand and an eagle-eyed guide leading the way, you'll spot frigate birds swooping overhead, ibis hiding out in the mangroves, parrots filling up on almonds in the treetops and maybe even a woodpecker or two.
